

2026 BARE ROOT FRUIT TREES

Rootstocks:

This year we have added the rootstock of the plants that we have ordered in order to better inform our customers of what they will be ordering or planting. Rootstocks are important for fruit trees because they can control tree size, and improve disease resistance, pest resistance, hardiness, cropping ability, and overall health.

Chill Hours:

Chill hours are the number of hours a fruit tree spends in temperatures below 45°F during the winter months while it's dormant. This period of cold exposure is essential for the tree to break dormancy and grow properly in the spring.
