Using drought-tolerant perennials and grasses can make a garden full of color, texture and fragrance. At the same time this garden will take very little water to maintain.

Newly planted drought-tolerant perennials, as with any plant, will still need watering, especially the first calendar year. These perennials will need frequent watering to help in the development of new top growth and more importantly root growth to sustain them through drought conditions.
