Planting Instructions

1. Dig a hole 2x as wide and 6" deeper than the pot/root-ball
2. Fill the hole with water – The water should drain entirely by the next day. If water remains, repeat this step.
3. Mix the recommended soil at an approximate rate of 50/50 with your native soil along with the proper amount of starter fertilizer
4. Remove excess soil mixture from the hole and set aside to be used later; When setting your plant in the hole it should sit an inch to an inch-and-a-half above ground level
5. Fill the hole with the remaining soil mix around the root-ball while leaving a berm on top for watering
6. Water thoroughly and allow to drain - If B-1 was recommended, after this initial watering drains water your plant again with a mixture of 1 tsp. Root Master B-1 to each gallon of water. Water with a B-1 Mixture once a week for the next three weeks
7. *For trees requiring stakes:* Stake with two lodge poles approximately 8" from the trunk on opposite sides of the tree. Tie stakes to tree as shown in the diagram.
