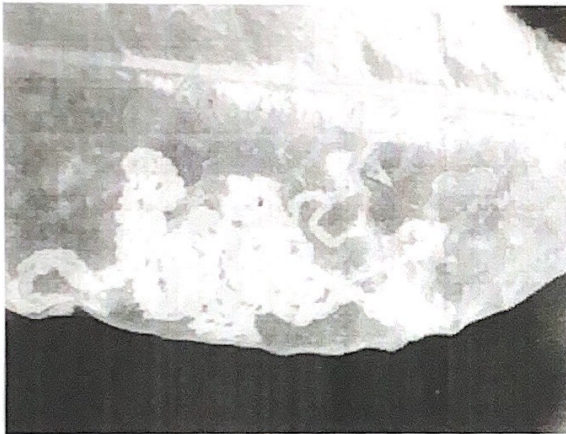


Citrus Leafminer

What is it?

- Leafminers are insects that feed within a leaf, producing large blotches or meandering tunnels.
- Although leafminer injuries are conspicuous, most leafminers produce injuries that have little, if any, effect on plant health.



What do I do?

- No immediate action is necessary. The damage is mostly ornamental and will not cause any harm to your plant.
- Do not prune off damage in the winter or you risk your plant freezing. When the weather warms, you may prune off the damage and treat your plant with a Seaweed Extract to promote new growth.
- Set Citrus Leafminer traps when the weather warms up, typically in late February.
